You can get to Univerity Of Piraeus by metro, tram, bus, or taxi.



For public transport (metro, tram & bus, not including from/to airport lines), the same ticket works across all services, and is time-limited but you can take unlimited rides within the ticket's validity period.

- 90 - minute ticket: 1.20€
- 2 x 90 - minute ticket: 2.30€
- 5 x 90 - minute ticket: 5.70€
- All Day ticket: 4.10€
- 5 Day ticket: 8.20€

Tickets must be paid in Euro (EUR). You can buy them:

- From ticket machines at metro and train stations
- Directly on the metro entrance, inside buses and trams (NFC card payment)
- Through mobile apps like "ATH.ENA GO" 
- Make sure to validate your ticket at the start of your trip! Traveling without a valid ticket may result in a fine of 100€.
- If you prefer a taxi, apps like FREENOW, Uber and Bolt are widely used.

TRANSPORT FROM THE AIRPORT



Athens International Airport "Eleftherios Venizelos" (ATH)



The most recommended public transport option from the **ATH** Airport is the metro. Metro line **M3 (Blue Line)** connects the metro station "**Airport**" with the metro station "**Dimotiko Theatro**" (nearest metro station from the University Of Piraeus). To get to the metro station, starting from the arrival level you will need to cross the street and go up the escalators to the **departures level** or go to the departures level from inside of the airport building. Then head to the bridge opposite the entrance of the departures level and then follow the flat escalators all the way into the Airport Metro Hall.

Another option are the city buses. You may find those just outside **Exit 5** on the **Arrivals Level**. Route **X96** will take you to **Piraeus** at the "**Demotiko**" stop from where you can walk to the University, although using the bus will most likely take longer. Note that Ride - Hailing services like FREENOW and Uber are also available although they are typically more expensive when taken from the airport or heading towards due to additional fees.

~ IMPORTANT !!! ~

To use public means of transport routes (metro, train & bus) that **go to or depart from** the Airport, a special airport route fare needs to be purchased from the ticket machines inside all Metro Stations or the machines next to some of the Bus stops. These come in the following costs and packages.



- One way trip using Express Bus Lines ticket (X96 in our case): 5.50€
- 90 - minute airport metro ticket: 9€
- Airport Metro Round Trip ticket: 16€ (Round trip is valid for 30 days after first use)

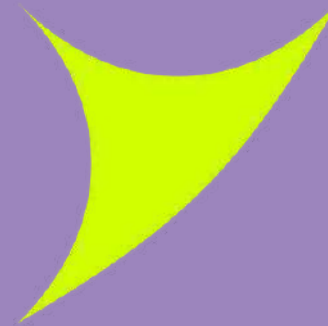
